キャンプ・シュワブ及び辺野古弾薬庫を、新たな任務に対応できるように、再設計・拡張する。辺野古弾薬庫にかかる計画変更は、13の弾薬庫を解体し、新たに12の弾薬庫と武器の組み立て区画を設置することを含む。この建設には未開発地を含む大規模な土木工事を必要とする。

11.2 Projected Changes in Facilities

There are significant changes proposed for Camp Schwab as part of the FRF, including moving the aviation unit, command function and all facilities, and the transfer of all airfield related facilities from MCAS Futenma. There will also be adjustments to the WSA. Camp Schwab and the Henoko Ordnance Ammunition Depot will be reconfigured and extensive construction will occur to accommodate the new mission. Timing for the operation of the FRF is projected to be 2022 or later (MOFA 2013).

Proposed changes for the Henoko Ordnance Ammunition Depot include demolishing 13 magazines and replacing them with 12 non-propagating, wall magazines and a weapons assembly area. The construction will require significant earth-work and disturbance of undeveloped land.
